 - AHRI certificate, AND
 - Heat Loss/Heat Gain Calculation/Manual (for every measure except Heat Pump Water Heater)
- Submit all documentation one of three ways:

- Be sure the quantity, make, model number and unit price of each item appear on the invoice.

INCENTIVE OFFER

- The programs may be changed or cancelled at any time without notice. The member and contractor are responsible for contacting the electric cooperative to ask whether or not the program is still in effect and to verify program parameters. These incentives are valid only for equipment purchased and installed on or after January 1, 2012 and before January 1, 2013.
- The maximum total incentive payment per member for all eligible projects and equipment types purchased and installed on or after January 1, 2012 and before January 1, 2013 is \$10,000.
- Program Discretion: Incentives are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Incentive amounts and offerings are subject to change or termination without notice at the discretion of Wabash Valley Power Association.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

- Incentives are available for retrofit of functioning equipment, replacement of failed or non-functioning equipment.
- Incentive items must be installed on the electric cooperative account listed on the application.
- All equipment must be new; used or rebuilt equipment is not eligible for an incentive.
- Equipment must meet the minimum specifications and terms and conditions listed in this application form. Wabash Valley Power Association reserves the right to withhold payment for products that do not meet the requirements.
- Single-family homes and multi-family dwellings of up to 5 units are eligible for incentives.

APPLICATION DELIVERY

- A signed application and installation invoice(s) must be received by Wabash Valley Power Association within 60 calendar days of the installation completion date. Invoice(s) submitted must include manufacturers' make and model numbers for each incentive item and/or original equipment manufacturer (OEM) specification sheets. Incentives are paid as a one-time, one-program offer and may or may not be combined with incentive payments from other Wabash Valley Power Association member cooperative programs. Call your local cooperative for additional information.
- All completed submissions become the property of Wabash Valley Power Association and will not be returned. Please keep a copy for your records.

PAYMENT

- The incentive payment cannot exceed the total material cost.

VERIFICATION

- Wabash Valley Power Association reserves the right to inspect a member's residence for installation of materials listed on this incentive application and will need access to survey the installed project. If the inspection finds the member did not comply with program rules and standards, any incentive you have received must be returned to Wabash Valley Power Association.
- Wabash Valley Power Association reserves the right to refuse payment and participation if the member or contractor violates program rules and procedures. Wabash Valley Power Association is not liable for incentives promised to members as a result of the contractor misrepresenting the program.
